HUMAN: Convictions

Eph 4:14-15 "Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of people in their deceitful scheming. 15 Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ."

Scripture tells us that followers of Jesus should know what our convictions are. We should know what we believe and why we believe it. But our convictions should always be enveloped, defined, and initiated by love. "Speaking the truth in love" is not always something we're good at. Some people are good at speaking the truth. Others are good at making people feel loved. But we should learn to be good at both!

Questions for Dialogue with your student:

1. What do you remember from the talk this night at echo?
2. What are convictions? How are convictions different from opinions? What are some of YOUR convictions?
3. What is the difference between disagreeing and judging?
