HUMAN: Wounds

Romans 8:28 says "And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love Him, who have been called according to His purpose."

All of us have experienced hurts and wounds in our lives. Our bodies usually know how to heal themselves—but our hearts and souls sometimes have a more difficult time. However, scripture tells us that God works through even the most difficult things to bring goodness and beauty in our lives.

This does not mean that God *causes* the hurts and the wounds, but it means that when they happen, He doesn't allow them to be for nothing. He will always bring beauty from the ashes.

Questions for Dialogue with your student:

1. What do you remember from the talk this night at echo?
2. What is the difference between God *causing* our wounds and God *using* our wounds for good?
3. What kinds of wounds have you experienced in your life? How might God use these wounds for good?
